Section I Introduction







About Us

The Sri Badrika Ashram cum Charitable & Social Welfare Society, a not-for-profit organisation whose purpose is serving the rural communities surrounding it and the society at large. The registered office and premises of the Society are situated in Village-Shalamu in the Sirmour district of Himachal Pradesh. The Society is registered under the Himachal Pradesh Societies Registration Act 2006. It has exemptions under Section 12AA & 80G of the Income Tax Act.

The Ashram was founded by the venerable saint Om Swami in 2011, as a simple hut made of mud. After his intense tapas in the Himalayan caves and jungles, Swamiji decided to settle in a remote valley deep in the lap of Himachal to revive the dormant practices of Dhyana Yoga and Mantra Sadhana. Swamiji's simple mantra of, Live, Love, Laugh, Give is the very basis of all endeavours at the ashram.

Message from Project Lead

We made tremendous progress in the first year of our operations, with the hard work of the volunteers, generous donors, and with Sri Hari's blessings. SBA EYSMS started in June 2021, and in our first year, we supported 108 students through our scholarship program. Over 70% of these were girls, and 75% of the students came from rural schools.

Himachal Pradesh is a rural state, with close to 90% rural areas – the highest in India. Data shows about 60% + of students drop out after 12th grade in Himachal, and we want to reduce that number. We will do this by providing 100% scholarships of tuition fees and providing an ongoing mentorship to students through an experienced mentor. Driven by the values of our founder, we want to focus on quality of the intervention, and not the quantity or count of students we reach. We will continue to focus on education of girl students, and also rural students. Education can break the vicious cycle for poverty for many of these families.

At the time of writing this, we had over 28 MOU's with leading universities and colleges, including IIT Mandi, NIT Hamirpur, HP University, IGMC, JUIT and several others. We invite these colleges to provide us students meeting our criterion of need and merit. We also accept direct applications from students who are taking admission in other colleges. Over 90% of the funds are allocated towards students from Himachal Pradesh domicile or studying in Himachal Pradesh. We also were able to bring our scholarship application process completely online so that we can scale, and the students have visibility into their application process.

The role of all the team members cannot be understated in such a massive intervention. We have over 65+ volunteers, some working full time, and a lot working part-time, on a completely pro-bono basis on the scheme. Their dedication towards making an impact on the lives of these students makes our program what it is.

We have also been supported by several generous donors, who care deeply about the cause. We would like to thank all the donors, for their continued support. We are looking forward to 2022–23 where we can help even more students fulfil their goals.

The ambitious vision of this project is to provide quality education at the college undergraduate level - to as many students as possible of Himachal Pradesh, belonging to primarily BPL (below-the-poverty-line) families.

At its very core, this scheme entails financial help and professional guidance to driven students with potential. These deserving students are prevented from turning their dreams into reality due to limited financial means or difficult life circumstances. Scholarships provided by SBA help to alleviate the financial burden of these families who wish for a secure future through the power of education.

61 lac people, which is 90% of Himachal Pradesh's population live in rural areas. They have little to no exposure to the dynamic pace of the outside world or any prospects for growth or professional careers.

The state is home to many educational institutes and universities that offer a wide variety of courses and specialisations.

There are 5 Universities, 2 Medical Colleges, 4 Dental Colleges, and 2 Engineering Colleges in the state. There are over 10,000 secondary schools and more than 1300 schools in this region.



At SBAEYSMS, special MOU's are signed with reputed and renowned institutes of HP. Himachal Pradesh University (HPU), IIT-Mandi, NIT-Hamirpur, IHM- Hamirpur, Jaypee University of Information Technology to name a few are some of our partners.

In 2021–22, 108 talented students have already been awarded these scholarships. The stage is all set for this to be one of the most inspiring initiatives from the ashram that will have a great impact on the lives of aspiring children.

Every case is evaluated individually taking into account the aptitude, interests, and preferences of each student. Ranging from career streams, as varied as Law to Veterinary Sciences, each child's dream is respected and treated with care. Each of them is deemed a powerhouse of potential to be sent out to a world of equal opportunities, so that they can fulfil their dreams and have the best chance at a more prosperous life.

SBA Emerging Youth Scholarship & Mentorship Scheme



An associated opportunity identified is to assist students with the fee for professional-grade coaching, to help them crack major competitive entrance exams like JEE for Engineering, NEET for Medical, etc. A tie-up for online coaching has already been initiated by the ashram with a prestigious coaching institute in Mumbai.

To keep the ball rolling in the direction of growth, there is a moral obligation or understanding with the students to Pay-it Forward in the future, by contributing at least 5% of their future income towards educating other children from similar disadvantaged backgrounds who are helpless to change their circumstances.





Mission & Program Goals

This project's 5-year plan is to provide scholarships, mentorship, and career counselling to 3000 students.

Our goal is

- To increase the percentage of students graduating from professional courses in Himachal Pradesh
- Their holistic development through:

Career Counselling during school years
Scholarship for undergraduate education
Professional Mentorship during the scholarship period, and
Job Readiness programs

- We aspire to reach the remotest parts of the state of H.P.
- Our target audience is the rural population of Himachal Pradesh, mainly belonging to low-income families and preferably female students.

Part-1

Scholarships & Financial Assistance

We provide scholarships for high-quality undergraduate education, along with professional mentorship, for need and merit-based students of Himachal Pradesh. We engage with universities through special MOUs to identify students with a mix of criteria ranging from their family income levels, academic history, and family structure.

Eligibility Criteria for Scholarship recipients: -

- Students studying at the undergraduate level
- BPL families
- Low-Income families <3 Lac per year
- Orphans and single-parent households
- Chronic/terminal illness in the family
- Ex-servicemen, daily wage labourers
- Multiple daughter households
- Meritorious students > 90% in class 12




Performance In The Past Year: Key Highlights

Total Awardees = 108


Family Category:

Of the 108 students awarded scholarships in 2021-22, 69.4% were Above Poverty Line (APL) and the remaining 30.6% fell Below the Poverty Line (BPL).



Gender-wise:


72.2% were girl awardees marking the achievement of our scheme's focus target group.






Analysis of the APL households revealed that:

- 1. Most of them (42.7%) were children of low-income government/private employees.
- 2. Followed by 25.4% of children of low-income farmers and
- 3. 22% belonged to single-parent households
- 4. The remaining 6.7% of the pie are orphans and 2.7% are battling some serious medical condition.



School Type:

One of our targets of assisting more students from rural HP was achieved as illustrated below. 74.1% of the students were from rural high schools.






Course Type:

More than half of HP's high school graduates do not pursue a formal higher education. One of the primary goals of the SBA EY SMS Scheme is to reduce this number and encourage more students to complete a professional undergraduate course. 86.1% of the 2021-22 awardees enrolled in Bachelor courses across the state of Himachal Pradesh.






Course Classification:

The bar chart below shows the various types of Diploma and Bachelor courses chosen by the recipients in 2021-22.

As evident, the maximum number of students opted for the science stream in high school. In the diploma category, the majority are GNM which is a diploma in General Nursing and Midwifery. The financial support has led them to continue their pursuit of education.


Mentorship – Buddy Program

Every student is provided the opportunity of tailor-made mentorship guidance and a learning plan for bridging the soft skill gaps as well as a program focused on communication, personality development, and self-awareness.

Our team of exceptional mentors come from varied backgrounds ranging from Supreme Court advocates, professors from IIT & US universities, successful entrepreneurs, doctors to senior academicians from public schools.

Mentors are matched to students based on their course of study to:

- be successful in their chosen field
- be effectively placed after graduation
- identify functional soft skill gaps for each scholar through an Al-based psychometric test run on Bodhami's platform.





Career Guidance Webinars

We plan on launching a Career Guidance Webinar Series in FY 2022-23 for the scholars to help guide them on their path to a great career. This series has a several pronged approach which aims to provide the scholars:

- with an opportunity to interact with veterans from the industry
- guideposts on career and higher studies options'
- a way to understand the on- and off- campus placement process
- pathways towards setting up start-ups and/or entrepreneurship





The first of this series was held on May 15th, 2022 by Mr. Vikram Rajoria who shared his insights regarding career possibilities in the Hospitality & Hotel Management Industry. Mr. Rajoria has worked in the Food & Beverage (F&B) industry for more than 17 years in hotels like the Leela Kovalam, Hilton Group and Accor Group of Hotels.

Next in line was the webinar on "Careers in Teaching & Academics" co-hosted by SBA and St. Bede's College, Shimla, and held on May 29th, 2022. The panelists included a Vice-Principal of Ambience Public School, Delhi, Professor Haneet Gandhi (Dean of Admissions, Delhi University) and a highly accomplished and successful mentor Mr. Praveen Sharma.

The 3rd webinar co-hosted with the University of Information Technology, Shimla was held on July 3rd, 2022 on "Careers in Engineering". This was a lively discussion with IIT-alumni, veterans from Wipro, Intel & Microsoft, entrepreneurs, and angel investors who are the scheme's volunteer mentors.

School Career Counselling Program

What's to come - FY 2022-23:

Collaboration with JNV Schools:



Through a tie-up with the Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti (NVS) we are in the process of starting a Career Counselling & Mentoring Program with the 12 JNV schools in HP. The pilot is commencing on August 6th 2022 with JNV, Theog located near Shimla, HP.

The target group is class 9 and above. We intend to provide scientifically matched career and high school stream options based on each student's persona, interest and skills.



Free Coaching for competitive exams:



We have tied up with PACE institute Mumbai, to offer free online coaching for competitive entrance exams. The students identified from our counselling and mentorship program, who wish to give competitive exams will be provided free coaching. Meritorious students who apply directly will also be considered.

Informative session at Higher Secondary Schools:

To target the low enrolment rate in professional undergraduate courses, our outreach involves visiting schools, especially in rural regions. We conduct informative sessions at high schools discussing the advantages of higher education, a multitude of college/career options available today, and above all no dream is too big.

Next Batch of Scholarships - We have started selection for our next batch of scholarships recipients. For the year 2022-23, so far we have awarded scholarships to 71 students from 12 colleges, which is part of the 200+ planned new scholarships. 52 of these are girl students, and 46 of them come from rural areas.

Sri Badrika Ashram's mission is to help alleviate the economically weaker sections of Himachal Pradesh's community. To realize this goal, the ashram is also engaged in several other programs such as:

Sri Hari Chikitsa Kendra – administers free healthcare to villagers who have no easy access to basic health needs. It is a fully functional dispensary run by a resident doctor.

Medical & Dental Camps - regular free and customized medical and dental camps are held at nearby villages for people who cannot travel to the ashram for their healthcare needs.


Stitching Training Centres – empowerment of women is imperative to the overall growth of a community. To that effect the ashram runs 4 stitching centres in the neighbouring villages. The local women are taught valuable skills to become financially independent.

Gaushala – the ashram runs and maintains a gaushala which nurtures and tends to more than 20 cows and calves.

Other Projects - SBA continues to impact the lives of the locals by facilitating livelihood projects:

- · Construction of public restrooms in Dudham
- Renovation of the Shalamu Government Primary School
