

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

Introduction of SBA-EYSMS

In July 2021, Sri Badrika Ashram (SBA) cum Charitable and Social Welfare Society launched the SBA Emerging Youth Scholarship and Mentorship Scheme (SBA-EYSMS). This initiative aims to empower and uplift promising young minds, nurturing them to become future leaders and change-makers within their communities.

Mission

Dedicated to serving local rural communities, Sri Badrika Ashram operates from its registered office in the village of Shalamu, Post-Kargaanum District, Sirmour, Himachal Pradesh. The society is registered under the Himachal Pradesh Societies Registration Act 2006 and enjoys tax exemptions under Sections 12AA and 80G of the Income Tax Act.



Founding and Vision

Founded in 2011 by the venerable saint Om Swami, the ashram began as a humble single hut made of mud. Before his renunciation, Swami Ji was a successful serial entrepreneur with a software business spanning five continents. He gave up his multi-million-dollar enterprise to seek spiritual truth, undergoing intense tapas in the Himalayan caves and jungles. With over 15,000 hours of meditation and mantra sadhana, Swami Ji settled in this remote valley to revive the glory of the Vedas and Sanatan Dharma. His simple mantra, "Live, Love, Laugh, Give," forms the foundation of all activities at the ashram.

Message from Program Lead

In our third year of operations, we introduced an innovative fully sponsored BCA program for girls in collaboration with Eternal University & NavGurukul. This program focuses on student-centered, Al-integrated education to equip students for the changing job market, emphasizing self-directed learning, peer collaboration, and a redefined facilitator role to promote agency, inclusivity, and personal growth.

Continuing to enhance our program with an even higher social impact focus, we made the following improvements:

- Implemented an annual assessment test to give us and students feedback on industry readiness.
- Enhanced our selection process by focusing more on streams and colleges.
- Offered a 3-month coding bootcamp to enhance employability for engineering students seeking software careers.

In 2023-24, we supported 233 scholars through our scholarship program, disbursing over 1.2 crores in scholarships, with over 70% going to girls and 75% from rural schools. Our goal over the next five years is to impact the lives of 1500 students and their families.

We are proud to have over 70+ volunteers, working on a completely probono basis for this program. Their dedication towards making an impact on the lives of these students makes our program what it is. We are grateful for the generous donors who share our commitment to the cause. At its core, this scheme provides financial assistance and professional guidance to motivated students with great potential. Many deserving students are hindered from achieving their dreams due to limited financial means or challenging life circumstances. The scholarships offered by SBA help alleviate the financial burdens on these families, paving the way for a secure future through the power of education. In our society today, education is the most important tool for progress. An educated individual is free, independent, and capable of contributing to the growth of their community and country.



Himachal Pradesh is home to 61 lakh people, with 90% of its population living in rural areas. These communities often have little or no exposure to the dynamic pace of the outside world or opportunities for professional growth and careers.

Despite this, the state boasts numerous educational institutes and universities offering a wide variety of courses and specializations. There are 5 universities, 2 medical colleges, 4 dental colleges, and 2 engineering colleges in the state, along with over 10,000 secondary schools and more than 1,300 higher secondary schools.

The SBA EYSMS model includes signing special Memorandums of Understanding (MOUs) with reputed and renowned institutes in Himachal Pradesh, such as Himachal Pradesh University (HPU), IIT-Mandi, NIT-Hamirpur, IHM-Hamirpur, and Jaypee University of Information Technology. These partnerships are designed to attract the best scholars to our program, ensuring they receive the support and opportunities they need to succeed.






Program Overview

As of the end of the 2023-24 period, 230 SBA Scholars were actively participating in the program. The approach at SBA EYSMS is holistic, with scholarships as the gateway into our comprehensive support system. Once inducted, scholars have the opportunity to join a variety of programs designed to enhance their personal and professional growth:

- English Training & Communication
- Career Guidance Webinars with Industry Experts

Scholars are evaluated individually, focusing on their aptitude, interests, and preferences. Career streams cover a broad spectrum, from Law to Veterinary Sciences. Our team, dedicated to this noble cause, comprises over 65 passionate, qualified, and talented volunteers. We launched this unique degree in partnership with Eternal University, along with NavGurukul, which provides unique experiential and peer led pedagogy, with very high placement rates.



Financial Assistance through Scholarship

To reduce the number of drop-outs after 12th grade in Himachal Pradesh, we provide scholarships for undergraduate education. We partner with universities and colleges to identify eligible students based on need and merit.

Mentorship Program

In line with our aim to help our students with holistic development and help them succeed in their respective courses, we run the mentorship program under which students receive guidance from experts from respective fields. Our team of mentors comprises accomplished individuals from diverse backgrounds, including Venture capitalists, Angel investors, IT experts, Supreme Court advocates, IIT professors, Eminent doctors, Educationists, and Psychologists. This ensures that each student is matched with an industry veteran who shares a similar field or background, guaranteeing relevant and personalized mentorship.

The mentors help the scholars by helping them chart the right career path and other aspects such as personality development, communication skills, creative abilities, decision making etc. Our mentors actively assist in creating internship opportunities and industry-relevant projects for the mentees. They keep the students informed about the latest developments in their respective industries, ensuring they stay ahead and well-prepared for their future endeavours.

In order to provide personalised guidance to each mentee, we conduct a comprehensive life skills assessment with the help of a specially curated test.




This assessment helps us identify the specific areas where mentees require guidance and improvement. Through sustained and regular monthly sessions, as well as check-ins, mentors work closely with mentees to address these life skill gaps effectively and provide a consistent support system and a platform for mentorship discussions. 2000 + Mentorship sessions were held in 2023-2024.

Always striving to be better at what we do, we have made some changes to the Mentorship Program. These are as follows:

- Due to the increase in the number of scholars and to provide an even focused mentorship we have divided our scholars into four defined Streams namely:
- 1. Engineering
- 2.Law
- 3. Medical
- 4. Humanities & Hospitality
- Inclusion of all students under the mentorship program: Students now have two options, they can either opt for long-term, personalised mentorship or receive periodic guidance by reaching out to the panel of mentors under each stream.
- Stream-wise division of all activities: We now have team leads for each stream who are responsible for the smooth functioning of all stream related activities. Team leads prepare the Annual program calendar for each stream which include Career webinars, contact sessions and training and ensure the implementation of the same with the help of Mentors.
- **Goal-based approach:** All scholars are now required to work on a goal setting form with the help of their mentors/guides. A well defined goal is then aimed at by breaking it down into smaller milestones which the scholars work on, under the able guidance of their mentors.

Mental Health Support

Today's youth is facing Mental health challenges like never before seen in the History of mankind, all thanks to Social Media and Blue screen addictions. Cut throat competition and the scarcity of jobs aggravate the problem even further. The Mentorship team keeps a close watch on the well-being of the scholars.



"Mind Management", a series of Mental health awareness webinars was conducted by the Mentorship Lead, Avneet Kaur Sidhu in the month of September 2023 to help scholars identify and reach out in case of any such challenge they may face.

English and Communication Skills Program

English, the "Lingua Franca," is spoken by over a quarter of the global population and dominates digital media content. In today's workplace culture, English proficiency is more crucial than ever for personal growth and excellence. However, many students feel disheartened when they struggle to communicate effectively in English. To address this issue, we have developed a tailored **English and Communication Skills Program** for the scholarship students.


Our program, initiated in June 2022, focuses on enhancing students' spoken and written English abilities. Some key factors are:

- It aims to help them overcome inhibitions, gain confidence, and adeptly handle both formal and informal situations.
- Our dedicated team of teachers has committed over 200 hours to meticulously plan, research, design, and deliver 30-hour sessions.
- Throughout the program, students receive personalised instruction, mentoring, coaching, and individual evaluations in the areas of Listening, Speaking, Reading, and Writing (LSRW) skills.
- The foundation level requires a minimum passing percentage of 50%, and more than 75% of students successfully completed the course, with the highest score achieved being 95%.

In March 2023, we launched the second batch of the Foundation Program and the first batch of the Intermediate Level, each of 6 months duration. Over 80 students enrolled in these two levels of the English and Communication Program. The Foundation Program Batch 2 saw 28 students pass the program with 60% and above scores. The evaluations included mid-term and end-term written exams and viva.

The first batch of the Intermediate Program comprised the students who had cleared the foundation program. It focused more on the Spoken English and Communication Skills of the students and preparing them for the Employment. 18 students cleared this level with more than 80% scores. The evaluation comprised of Written exams, Presentations, Viva and Speeches. These students passed out in December 2023.

In February 2024, the English program was revamped into 2 separate programs looking at the specific needs of the students. "Entrance Exam English and Grammar" was launched for students who want to work more on their Grammar aspect to clear various Entrance exams. "Mastering Spoken English" was launched for students who want to focus more on honing their Spoken English. Both the programs will end in November 2024.







Career Guidance Webinars

Career guidance webinars were offered in FY 2023-24 to current students of the scholarship scheme, with a goal to provide preparation for their future career paths.

Webinar objectives:

- To provide expert guidance to students for career-related decisions (by live interaction, Q&A with veterans from their field of study)
- Explain career & higher studies options (including the pros & cons of pursuing a master's degree)
- Deliver knowledge about soft skills required to succeed professionally
- Educate about pathways towards becoming an entrepreneur
- To educate them about on-campus & off-campus placement process

Career Webinars held in 2023-24

A webinar on **Decision Making** was held in the month of April 2023 with Vikram Shastry, **CEO** at **Black Lotus Technologies.** Black Lotus Technologies is the creator of one of the most impactful meditation apps in the world – "Black Lotus" where meditation and virtues come together to create a better world.

Vikram Shastry is a graduate of Computer Science Engineering from MSRIT Bangalore. Having worked with leading tech companies, he has been involved in building ERP solutions along with training graduates and laterals in advanced programming. Vikram has trained more than 20,000 individuals in advanced programming in a classroom.










In the month of May 2023, another Webinar on Adaptability towards Change was held by Niren Patel, Cofounder and CEO of FyuGén Inc. USA.

Niren Patel is an IIT BHU alumni with MS in Computer Science and Business Analytics. He is a professional firmly rooted in India, with а strong background in Leadership Development, Management, Entrepreneurship, and Team Building. He enjoys problem-solving and finding insights through state-of-the-art Data Science and Analytics techniques, using visualizations, AI, and Machine Learning.

Come July 2023, the students participated in another Webinar on Mastering Technical Writing.

It was conducted by Rajesh Kodukala who holds a degree in Mechanical Engineering and also a M.Tech in Materials Engineering from NITK, Surathkal.

Rajesh has worked in the Oil and Gas with sector for 5 vears Allseas Engineering BV and spent 6 years in the aerospace sector with Rolls Royce. Currently, he is employed at the start-Log9, contributing to up the development of world-class batteries for electric vehicles with a focus on promoting manufacturing these batteries in India.









In August 2023, Hetal Sonpal conducted an interesting webinar for the students on **Reading**.

Hetal is a **TEDex Speaker** and a **veteran** in the technology industry. In an engaging talk, Hetal drive home a point on how Reading can transform one's life in both the professional and personal space.

In the month of October 2023, the students were exposed to yet another Webinar by the name "It's about making time" where two eminent speakers and entrepreneurs, Hetal Sonpal and Megha Vashishtha deep dived into the art and techniques of balancing schedules, academics and commitments personal boost to productivity.



FAMILY CATEGORY 2023-24




Break up of the APL Classification

- 13% of the students belong to low income farmers & 10% to single parent households.


APL CLASSIFICATION 2023-24

GENDER TYPE






With 54% of the students from rural high schools, the program continues to make inroads into rural India. One of the goals of the program is to promote the benefits of education in HP. Currently, 68% of the cohort for FY2023-24 is from HP.

SCHOOL TYPE 2023-24




STATE DISTRICT 2023-24






Course Type








Feedback from Graduating Scholars

2. 100% scholars felt that the scheme was important or extremely important for their education.







3. Around 71% scholars felt that the mentorship scheme was helpful or extremely helpful.



4. All 79% of students who signed up for English Language and Communication classes found them helpful or extremely helpful.




5. 91% of the students were planning to study further.

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
